THIS BOOKLET CONTAINS THE MISSIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR HOPE PRESBYTERIAN IN THE 2024 TO 2028 YEARS.

It has developed from continued prayer and discernment by Hope's elders and leadership over an 18 month period.

The Framework explains who we are as a one-church many-sites Christian church, the values that we hold as important, and God's mission for us in these years. It is the foundation out of which all our Hope Church sites will build and measure site-focused goals between 2024 and 2028. From it, God will help us work together to build hope in a broken world.

You will see building metaphors of living stones, our sure foundation and building blocks. Scripture supports them. They depict that we are to rely on God for the strength of stone, to actively mobilise and live out His mission for us, and to build on the priorities He has given us to reach, help and love people. We do so with the aid of His Holy Spirit, and in the security of what our Saviour Jesus Christ has done for us.

OUR CONTEXT

- Hope Presbyterian is one church that consists of multiple interdependent sites throughout the South-West of Christchurch, New Zealand. We aim to be a church that is local to each community we serve and global in following Christ Jesus as His disciples.
- Our church is made up of people from different cultures and ages joining together under our common faith in God. We collaboratively serve our local and global communities.

MISSIONAL PRIORITIES

Our values are foundational. They help direct our missional priorities. The five priorities, or building blocks, that God has led us as Hope Presbyterian to focus on during the 2024 to 2028 years are as follows.

1. DISCIPLING ALL GENERATIONS OF CHRISTIANS

We will grow inter-generational followers of Christ, by pointing them to the truth and freedom found only in Jesus Christ.

We will create opportunities, and remove obstacles, for people to "take a step toward Jesus" and to flourish as confident and generous followers of God.

We will develop future leaders for Christ.

We will set our hearts and minds on godly truth as it is revealed by the Holy Spirit in the Bible. Our love of this, and the only truth, will always be sustained by our joy-filled love of God and people.











2. PARTNERING WITH OTHERS TO REACH OUR COMMUNITIES AND OUR WORLD

As God has partnered with us, so we will call others to godly partnerships that are built on the cornerstone of Christ.



We aspire to be an appealing partner by demonstrating the love, unity, patience and diligence that is inspired by the Spirit. Our godly partnerships during 2024 to 2028 are to produce fruit for the Kingdom of God.

We desire to be flexible in our approach, supporting our people in their creativity and missional endeavours as the Holy Spirit inspires them.

We will be godly partners and engage with tangata whenua.



We will partner with others within our Hope network to reach our communities. We will partner with Hope World Wide to impact on the practical, social and spiritual needs of the places we are called to in the world.







3. BE A BEACON OF HOPE TO THOSE ON THE FRINGES

As Christ-followers we will be a beacon of hope in the world, offering a secure shelter in trying times.

We will be confident communicators of both the goodness and the truth of Christianity as revealed in scripture.

We will promote a culture that seeks justice and freedom for people who are marginalised by society.

We will respond with courage when we wrestle with the issues of our day.

Our beacon of hope will illuminate the God who loves all people, who died for them and who rose from the dead. In doing so we will provide hope and assurance of a forgiven past, a purposeful present, and a flourishing future with Him.





4. REACH THE HINTERLAND (THE UNCHARTED TERRITORY)

We will seek Holy Spirit-inspired wisdom to boldly reach outside our known communities into places where others may not go.

We will establish God's kingdom in previously unexplored areas or locations. This will encompass potential new sites, online space, and new forms of church.

We will also be open to God illuminating new opportunities in the mission field where our people are already at work.

As "people are our priority" is one of our values, we will prioritise loving and serving others. Our people and the new disciples that we will see will grow in faith because of it.

5. BE A WARM AND INVITING CHURCH THAT PEOPLE ARE HAPPY TO CALL HOME

We will be living stones. We will be vibrant, flexible and steadfast.

We will be known by the generosity of our love in action. We will be a church family that is warm and welcoming, and that offers genuine friendship to all.

We will honour those who came before and prepare the generations to come as a joyful and faithful witness.

We will diligently journey with others until Christ returns to take us home.
